

Enrolment Information 2011-2012

How to Enroll

For all courses except the Academic Year/Semester, Multi-Language Year and Advanced Diploma Programme.

Students may enroll by phone, online, by mail, at an EF office or with an EF representative. Please complete the Enrolment Form on the opposite page and send it to us with a copy of your passport and the non-refundable Enrolment Fee of £145. The Enrolment Fee may be paid by credit card.

Please note: for students enrolling in a course that begins within 30 days, please send the Enrolment Form, passport copy, Enrolment Fee and Course Fee. A non-refundable Courier Fee of £65 may be charged in order to expedite student enrolment.

For Academic Year Abroad & Multi-Language Year

Students who wish to book an Academic Year Abroad or Multi-Language Year will be sent the appropriate enrolment information.

What is included in your Course Fee?

- Course of choice
- Digital learning media and academic materials
- Shared room in residence or homestay, depending on destination. Accommodation is reserved from Sunday to Saturday (am), unless informed otherwise
- Breakfast & dinner Monday-Friday with all meals at weekends in homestay
- For EF International Language Centres where residence accommodation is included in the Course Fee, meals vary, please refer to each destination page.

What is not included in your Course Fee?

- EF Course Books
- Travel from home country to EF International Language Centre (unless otherwise specified)
- Transfer from airport to accommodation (please book arrival transfer)
- Transportation to and from the EF International Language Centre
- Internet/Wi-Fi in homestay or residence is not guaranteed
- Meals and snacks outside of above specified meal plan
- Official language exam testing fees (i.e. TOEFL Ibt, Cambridge ESOL, etc.) Prices for exams vary but an average exam fee is £100
- Some activities and most excursions require a participation fee. Prices vary depending on type of activity and excursion but as a guide an average day trip is £25-35 and weekend £100-200.

EF Course Books

***All transfers should make reference to the full name of the student in order to ensure quick and proper credit to his/her account. In cases where credit card payments are accepted, a fee may apply.**

Payment Plan

As soon as we receive the Enrolment Form with the Enrolment Fee, we will send a booking confirmation, along with an initial invoice detailing the payment due. A final invoice will be sent requiring the remaining balance, which is due at least 60 days prior to the course start date. If final payment is not received 60 days prior to the start of the course, EF reserves the right to charge a late payment fee for any amounts overdue.

Arrival and Airport Transfers

The fee for this optional transfer from your airport of arrival to your destination is listed on the EF International Language Centre pages 22-29. This covers the cost of administration, communication, greeting services and transportation. The transfer service is offered between 0700 and 2100 hours local time on Sundays. If students arrive at any other time, we can arrange a special transfer at an additional cost of £60. Please note a transfer from London to Manchester will cost £400.

Age

EF International Language Centres are open to everyone aged 16 years and over. EF Junior Summer Camps are for students aged 13-16 years old. Parents and guardians of students under the age of 18 are required to sign a Medical Release Waiver.

EF's Learning Guarantee

The learning guarantee only applies to the EF Language Courses Abroad. To qualify for the learning guarantee, students must attend all classes and complete all assignments. Students who choose to continue studying for free under our learning guarantee are responsible for all other costs, including but not limited to accommodation, meals, travel and visa fees.

If visa regulations prohibit a student from extending their stay in their study country, they can continue to study English for free when they return home online at EnglishTown.com with teacher-led classes.

iLabs

iLabs are currently available at all EF International Language Centres of English. All EF General courses include access to the iLab upon enrolment, throughout the course and a 3-month online post-course. All EF Intensive courses include access to the iLab upon enrolment, throughout the course and a 6-month online post-course.

My EF™ web service

All EF students will automatically receive an online account for My EF™. Any correspondence, photos and other media used on My EF™ will be considered private and EF will not accept any responsibility for such correspondence or media. Parent/s or legal guardian/s of students under the age of majority travelling with EF give their consent for the student to use the My EF™ web service.

Online One-to-One Package

This is a course supplement, available in combination with any EF Intensive or EF General course at our year-round English EF International Language Centres. The package includes six lessons of 40 minutes in length, with one teacher per student that is conducted online. Students can choose to take the lessons while at the EF International Language Centre or can also complete these lessons once returning home.

Course levels

A few weeks before students leave for their course, they will take the EF Level Placement Test online in iLab to assess their language level and ability. The results will be sent to their EF International Language Centre. On arrival they will be placed in the correct level at which they should begin their studies. When an EF International Language Centre has a General language lesson of five students or fewer, EF reserves the right to reduce the number of lessons per week.

Class Schedules and Duration of Lessons

EF Language lessons have a duration of 40 minutes, (except where stated otherwise on individual destination pages). Classes are offered at all EF centres worldwide in a block schedule format on weekdays from 8:00 to 20:00. In some centres, classes may take place on the weekends.

Public Holidays

EF International Language Centres are closed 25th, 26th December and 1st January. Missed classes will not be made up at a later date.

Travel and Medical Insurance

All students are required to have medical and accident insurance. We have negotiated tailor-made coverage for EF students with an international company expert in travel insurance - Entice Insurance Ltd. We strongly recommend this policy as it protects the student against expenses incurred through accident or illness, and provides coverage for loss or theft of baggage and personal effects. It also provides coverage against interruption of the student's EF course due to illness and includes Liability and Legal coverage. The cost of this insurance is £32 for the first two weeks, then £12 for each additional week. If the student does not wish to take this policy, they will need to provide EF with a copy in English of the alternative insurance policy they have taken out individually. Full policy details available on request.

Cancellations and Refund Policy

All cancellations and terminations must be made in writing to the nearest EF office, EF local representative or EF Centre Director. In all cases the Enrolment Fee and the Courier Fee are non-refundable.

In the event that the World Health Organization (WHO), or an international governmental health authority issues a country-specific travel warning or forbids travel, EF students have the right to postpone or re-book travel within a period of 365 days. If students wish to cancel, the above stated cancellation stipulations apply.

Cancellations

The Course Fee comprises two elements: Tuition Fee (40%) and the Student Services and Accommodation Fee (60%). The Tuition Fee is fully refundable if the student cancels more than 14 days prior to the course start date. Additional refunds will be made from the Student Services and Accommodation Fee as follows:

- If the student cancels 45 days or more before the start of the course the student will receive a full refund, except for the Enrolment Fee.

- If the student cancels less than 45 days prior to departure, EF will retain 40% of the Student Services and Accommodation Fee (maximum £1000) to cover the cost of pre-paid accommodation and services.

Late Arrivals and Absences

If the student arrives late or is absent during their course, no refund will be granted.

Withdrawals

All withdrawals need to be made in writing to EF. If the student wishes to withdraw from their course after arrival at the centre, they must inform the EF School Director and sign a copy of the course change notification form. Refunds are made by the EF office or representative where the course fees were paid.

If a student withdraws from their course after arrival at the centre they must give their EF School Director at least four (4) weeks advance notice. They will receive a full refund for all remaining weeks after the four-week notice period.

Prorated refunds will be calculated on a weekly basis. When determining the number of weeks, EF will consider a partial week the same as if a whole week were completed,

provided the student was present at least one day during the scheduled week.

Cancellation Protection

EF Enrolment Fee includes Cancellation Protection and is non-refundable. If students are forced to cancel before departure due to illness, or illness in their immediate family, EF will refund the Course Fee. Cancellation must be given in writing at their local EF office no later than the course start date. A doctor's documentation must be provided within ten days of the claim.

Re-booking Fee

Each time a student requests a change of destination, course dates, or type of accommodation after the initial enrolment, EF will charge a re-booking fee of £35 which is payable immediately. (This does not apply to students who are extending their course.) If a student changes the booking to another destination where fees are lower, the difference in fees between the destinations will not be refunded.

Protection for Our Customers

In order to ensure the well being of our students, EF has established a Code of Conduct, which all students are expected to follow.

Any student claims of course dissatisfaction should be reported to EF destination staff during their period of stay. If these complaints are not satisfied, they should be reported within 30 days after course completion at the student's local EF office.

Liability

EF will not be liable in any way to the student in the event of any service, contracted to be supplied by EF becoming impossible to supply by reason of industrial dispute or other cause outside the control of EF. EF will not be liable for loss, damage, or injury to persons or property howsoever caused, save where the liability is expressly imposed beyond exclusion by statute.

By accepting EF's terms and conditions, the participant accepts that EF freely can use all photography, film and sound material that has been created by EF and/or by EF's staff during the trip, without asking further approval from the participant.

Validity of Brochure Fees
